IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. The written test is conducted for the provisional shortlisting of Candidates for selection to the post of Project Assistant (PAD06) in Kerala Infrastructure Investment Fund Board (KIIFB).
2. Candidates securing minimum marks prescribed will be shortlisted based on group performance as decided by KIIFB. List of Candidates shortlisted for interview will be made available in KIIFB website. Only shortlisted candidates will be called for interview.
3. The written test will comprise of objective type questions from the following disciplines.

a) General Awareness	: 20 Nos.	}	Total 80 questions Duration : 90 minutes Medium : English
b) English Language	: 20 Nos.		
c) Quantitative Aptitude	: 20 Nos.		
d) Test of Reasoning & Computer Proficiency	: 20 Nos.		
4. All questions carry one mark each. Maximum marks for written test will be 80 (eighty). Each wrong answer will lose $\frac{1}{4}$ marks (Negative mark). Marking more than one answer or making alterations after marking an answer will result in negative marks. No negative mark for unattended questions.
5. Candidates will be provided with question booklet and OMR answer sheet. Candidates need to mark their answers in the OMR answer sheet using Ball Pen (black or blue) by darkening the specific bubble. No correction is possible.
6. The Provisional Answer Key of the Written Test will be published in the website www.kitcoplacementpark.in at 5.00 PM on 21st August 2017.

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. The Written Test will start at 11.00 am. Candidates should occupy their allotted seats in the examination hall by 10.30 am.
2. Candidates should bring the duly filled in Admit Card, with self attested passport size photograph affixed in the space provided, to the examination hall. Candidates also have to bring any one of the original photo ID card (Election ID / PAN card / Driving licence / Aadhaar Card / Passport etc.) for verification. No candidate will be permitted to appear for the examination without producing the Admit Card & Original Photo ID Card.
3. Candidates should hand over the Admit Card as and when demanded by the Supervisor / Invigilator. Candidates can keep "Candidate Copy" of the admit card for future reference as the "Office Copy" is to be returned at the time of Written Test.
4. Candidates are neither allowed to bring any book, paper or manuscript to the examination hall nor to communicate with each other.
5. Candidates are not allowed to use mobile phones, calculators or other such electronic equipment in the examination hall.
6. Candidates should bring ball point pen (black or blue) for appearing in the test.
7. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall till the end of the written test.
8. Candidates who are found engaging in malpractices in the examination hall will be disqualified.
9. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the written test.
